

HAZWOPER - Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response 29 CFR §1910.120 24-Hour Course - \$595 per person

OSHA HAZWOPER regulations specifically includes any employees who are exposed to hazardous substances and who are engaged in several operations including cleanup, treatment, storage and disposal of hazardous waste. In addition, workers involved in an emergency response operation dealing with hazardous waste and workers who have to perform duties at a waste site where hazardous contamination are equally expected to be fully trained and protected.

Employees and employers covered by the OSHA HAZWOPER standard are required to take the initial HAZWOPER training which consists of a 24 or 40-hour course. Depending on your job type and experience, you may be able to take the 24-hour course to meet your HAZWOPER training requirement. The 24-hour course covers broad issues pertaining to hazard recognition at work sites.

Respirator Fit Testing can be completed for an added cost of \$40 per person.
