

MSW A Supervisor Course – Course #0513

This is a 24-hour course for supervisors of Type I, IAE, IV and Type IVAE landfills and Type IX landfill mining operations.

Course will begin on Tuesday morning and end Thursday afternoon. Topics include the following:

- Qualifications for obtaining an initial license in accordance with the standards in 30 TAC 30 Subchapters A and F;
- Brief History of MSW;
- Permit and Registration authorization process – Parts I, II, III and IV of the application;
- Standard Air Permit authorizations;
- Multi-Sector General Permit/Storm Water Management;
- Contents of the Site Development Plan (SDP) – Part III of the application;
 - Surface Water Drainage System;
 - Liner System Design and Operation;
 - Leachate Collection System;
 - Landfill Gas Management (LFG);
 - Groundwater Monitoring and Corrective Action;
 - Closure and Post- Closure;
- Contents of the Site Operating Plan (SOP) – Part IV of the application;
 - Recordkeeping Requirements;
 - Fire Protection;
 - Access Control;
 - Control of Windblown Material;
 - Odor Management Plan;
 - Salvaging and Scavenging;
 - Compaction;
 - Landfill Cover;
 - Disposal of Special Waste.
- Standard Operating Procedures for Type V activities located at MSW Landfills;
- Surviving a TCEQ Inspection;
- Safe Operating Procedures.

This list is not inclusive of all topics covered.
