

## **MSW B Supervisor Course – Course #0514**

This is a 25-hour course for supervisors of Processing Facilities including recycling and composting facilities; medical waste management facilities; MSW transfer stations; Non-hazardous liquid waste processing facilities; Material Recycling Facilities (MRFs) and Type IX Energy Recovery facilities.

Course will begin on Tuesday morning and end Thursday afternoon. Topics include the following:

- Qualifications for obtaining an initial license in accordance with the standards in 30 TAC 30 Subchapters A and F;
- Brief History of MSW;
- Classification of MSW Facilities;
- Permit and Registration authorization process – Parts I, II, III and IV of the application;
- MSW Collection and Transportation;
- Operational Standards - Site Operating Plan (SOP) – Part IV of the application;
  - Recordkeeping Requirements;
  - Waste Acceptance and Analysis;
  - Fire Protection;
  - Access Control;
  - Citizens Collection Stations;
  - Control of Windblown Material;
  - Odor Management Plan;
  - Noise Pollution and Visual Screening;
  - Overload and Breakdown;
  - Sanitation;
  - Surface Water Drainage;
  - Closure Requirements for MSW Storage and Processing Units;
  - Financial Assurance;
  - Groundwater Monitoring;
- Medical Waste Management – 30 TAC 326;
- Permitted and Registered Composting Facilities – 30 TAC 332 & 328;
- Other types of Processing facilities;
- Surviving a TCEQ inspection/complaint inspection;
- Safe Operations.
